

CLERK OF THE YEAR AWARD NOMINEE

(Article 12.01) Two outstanding clerks of the Association shall be honored with a clerk of the year award. A county clerk and a district clerk, or county and district clerk representing either a county or a district clerk, shall be presented the outstanding clerk of the year award at the annual conference. Each clerk of the year nominee shall be an active member of the Association with a current continuing education certificate. The clerk of the year nominee shall, within the last year or two, have provided notable service to the Association while promoting the purpose of the Association. Prior year's contributions to the Association may also be considered in the nomination. *(Purpose of the Association [2.01] The purpose of the Association shall be to promote professional standards, to provide a means for the education of its members regarding the statutory and constitutional duties of the office of the county clerk and the district clerk, and to participate in the legislative, judicial and executive processes of the state government beneficial in the performance of the members' duties.)*

All the nominees for the clerk of the year awards shall be presented to the members at the annual conference with a Brief Description of the reason for their nomination.
